In a peaceful countryside setting sits the beautiful village of Fatima. Our Blessed Lady appeared to three shepherd children from May 13th until October 13th 1917 with her message of love and call to conversion. See how this magnificent Marian Shrine touches the hearts of so many who visit.



YOUR DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

DAY 1 NEWYORK

Depart on an international overnight flight to Lisbon. Dinner and breakfast are served aboard

DAY 2 FATIMA

Arriving in Lisbon, we are greeted by our tour guide and board our deluxe motor coach for a panoramic tour of the charming Portuguese capital. See the fanciful Belem Tower, Jeronimos Monastery, dedicated to the Virgin Mary, the Monument to the Discoveries and the Basilica of St. Anthony (patron saint of lost objects). Continue to Fatima with a stop in Santarem, one of the oldest cities in the world, to the Church of St. Stephen, which houses the Miracle of the Bleeding Host on continuous display since 1269 AD. Mass can be celebrated here before we depart for Fatima, arriving in the afternoon to check into our hotel. Balance of the day at leisure. In the evenings (if available) join in the moving Rosary Candlelight Procession beginning in the Little Chapel of the Apparitions (Capelinha). Dinner and overnight in Fatima. (D)

DAY 3 FATIMA

This morning we discover the hamlet of Aljustrel, the shepherd children's home. Continue to Valinhos, where Our Lady appeared after the children's release from prison. Visit the

church where they were baptized and the local cemetery. Take some time for private devotions before a video presentation on the history of Fatima. Later participate in the Rosary Candlelight Procession (if available). Dinner and overnight in Fatima. (B, D)

DAY 4 FATIMA

After breakfast we visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima, starting at the pristine Basilica, with the tombs of Jacinta and Francisco, beatified in 2000, and Sr. Lucia. Continue to the Little Chapel of Apparitions where Our Lady appeared to the three shepherd children to celebrate mass and light a candle near the shrine. The balance of the day is for reflection and meditation as we walk the lovely grounds and visit the new basilica that holds 9,000 pilgrims. Join in the Eucharistic Adoration and Reconciliation available each day at the basilica. After dinner we once again experience the Rosary Candlelight Procession (if available). Overnight in Fatima. (B, D)

DAY 5/6 FATIMA

These two days are at leisure. For pilgrims who wish to experience Christ's love, walk the Stations of the Cross along the Sacred Way (Via Sacra) ending at the Chapel of Calvary. Take time for private devotion, pray for the sick, drink water from the miraculous well. Take one of our optional tours (at additional cost) to visit the spectacular Gothic monasteries of Batalha and Alcobaca, and the colorful fishing village of Nazare. Visit the romantic city of Coimbra (at additional cost) where Sr. Lucia lived. Located on the River Mondego, Coimbra is one of Europe's oldest college towns. Visit the university, where students still wear long black capes, Se Velha (Old Cathedral), and the Monastery of Santa Cruz. Return to Fatima for some leisure time. After dinner take part in the Rosary Candlelight Procession (if available). Overnight in Fatima. (B, D)



DAY 7 NEWYORK, NY

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for our flight home, arriving the same day, taking with us memories and blessings to last a life time. (B)

LENTEN PILGRIMAGE TO FATIMA & LOURDES

Fatima is a peaceful village in Portugal where Our Blessed Lady appeared to three shepherd children from May 13th to Oct 13th 1917. Lourdes is located in the Pyrenees Mountains of France. Here in 1858 Our Lady visited Bernadette 18 times near the Grotto of Massabielle calling herself the Immaculate Conception.

YOUR DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

DAY 1 NEWYORK TO LISBON

Depart New York area gateway. Enjoy dinner and breakfast on overnight flight.

DAY 2 FATIMA

Arriving in Lisbon, we are greeted by our tour guide and board our deluxe motor coach for a panoramic tour of the charming Portuguese capital. See the fanciful Belem Tower, Jeronimos Monastery, dedicated to the Virgin Mary, the Monument to the Discoveries and the Basilica of St. Anthony (patron saint of lost objects). Continue to Fatima with a stop in Santarem, one of the oldest cities in the world, to the Church of St. Stephen, which houses the Miracle of the Bleeding Host on continuous display since 1269 AD. Mass can be celebrated here before we depart for Fatima, arriving in the afternoon to check into our hotel. Balance of the day at leisure. DAY 3 FATIMA

This morning discover the hamlet of Aljustrel, the shepherd children's home. Continue to Valinhos, where Our Lady appeared after the children's release from prison. Visit the church where they were baptized and the local cemetery. Take some time for private devotions before a video presentation on the history of Fatima. Later participate in the Rosary and the Candlelight Procession, if it is available. Overnight in Fatima. (B, D)

DAY 4 FATIMA

We visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima, starting at the pristine Basilica, with the tombs of Jacinta and Francisco, beatified in 2000, and Sr. Lucia. Continue to the Capelinha, where Our Lady appeared to the shepherd children. Light a candle near the shrine, walk the lovely grounds or shop for religious articles nearby. After dinner we can once again experience

the Rosary Candlelight Procession, if it is available. Overnight in Fatima. (B, D)

DAY 5 BURGOS

After breakfast we depart Fatima for Spain, driving along the rustic beautiful Portuguese countryside, before crossing the border into Spain. We continue to the city of Burgos, founded in the 9th century, the historic capital of Old Castle. We will have an orientation tour of the city highlighted by a visit to the imposing magnificent limestone Gothic Basilica, one of Spain's largest and most beautiful churches. Dinner and overnight in Burgos. (B, D)

DAY 6 LOURDES

We depart Burgos for Lourdes, enjoying the scenic ride through the rugged Pyrenees Mountains and travel into neighboring France. We arrive in the afternoon to visit the beloved Shrine of Lourdes, where in 1858 at the Grotto of Massabielle Our Lady appeared to the 14-year-old Bernadette Soubirous calling herself the "Immaculate Conception." Check into our hotel and after dinner we are invited to take part in the evening International Rosary Candlelight Procession (if available). Dinner and overnight in Lourdes. (B, D)

DAY 7 LOURDES

After breakfast our morning starts with a walking tour tracing the life of St. Bernadette, which includes visits to the Boly Mills where Bernadette was born; the Locale Mill, residence of her parents; the "Cachot," formerly used as a jail, where she lived at the time of the Apparitions; the Chapel where she received her First Holy Communion; and the Parish church containing the Font, where she was baptized. The afternoon is at leisure to pray and meditate at the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary, with its breathtaking murals, or take part in the Eucharistic Devotion, Blessed Sacrament Procession and praying for the sick. Tonight we are invited to participate in the International Rosary Candlelight Procession, (if available). Dinner and overnight, (B, D)

DAY 8 LOURDES

After Mass this morning at the Grotto, the whole day is at leisure for personal devotions; take the opportunity to drink the water from miraculous spring or submerge yourself in the "Healing Baths." In the evening we are invited to take part in the International Rosary Candlelight Procession if available. Dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 9 LOURDES/LISBON TO NEWYORK

Depart for the Toulouse airport for the return flight to Lisbon where we connect for our flight home. Arrive home the same day, taking with us memories and blessings to last a life time. (B)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Tour prices: All prices in this brochure are based on airfares, land rates and exchange rates in effect at the time of printing and on group rates of 22 passengers or more. Tours may depart with less than the required number of passengers, at the discretion of Group IST, LLC (doing business and referred to therein as "Regina Tours"), but an additional charge may apply. Passengers will be advised about such surcharges 60 days before departure. All prices are subject to change without notice prior to departure due to major currency fluctuations, changes in fuel prices and/or unforeseen economic circumstances.

Reservations, Deposits and Final Payments: Please complete the Participant Agreement, with full names as they appear on passports, and mail it to us with the required per person deposit plus applicable (optional) insurance. Receipt of your deposit shall act as your agreement to these terms and conditions. Balance is due 60 days before departure date. If final payment is received less than 60 days, a late fee will be assessed in the amount of \$50.00. If final payment is made by credit card (American Express, Visa, MasterCard), Regina Tours requires a completed credit card authorization form. All payments made by check should be made payable to Regina Tours.

Late Reservations If a booking is made within 60 days of departure, full payment plus applicable taxes and optional insurance is due at the time of booking. There will be a \$50.00 late processing fee applicable plus cost of any express or overnight mail services. No personal checks will be accepted with reservations received 30 days or less before departure date. Money order, bank check, certified check or credit cards (American Express, Visa, and MasterCard) will be accepted.

Travel Documents: A valid passport (valid for six months after the return date of the trip) is required to travel. Visa is required for US passport holders traveling to some destinations; please contact our office for details. All non-US citizens must contact the appropriate consular office for entry visa requirements pertaining to their trip. In addition non US citizens are responsible for complying with requirements for re-entry into the USA. Regina Tours assumes no responsibility for procurement of passport or visas. Obtaining and carrying these documents is the sole responsibility of passengers. Regina Tours will not be responsible for any delays, damages and/or losses, including missed portions of your trip due to improper travel documentation

Final Documents and Tickets All documents and tickets are only issued upon receipt of final payment and are sent within 3 weeks of departure. Documents and tickets are not guaranteed if final payment and booking form are not received on time.

Air from Home City: All brochure departures are based on a New York area airport. Regina Tours can help arrange air transportation from your home city airport. Regina Tours is not responsible for any penalties incurred on domestic tickets not purchased from us, in case of changes in the schedule of the tour. If you are making your own domestic airline tickets, please make sure that your domestic flight time arrives at least 4 hours prior to your international departure time.

Air Changes, Cancellations & Refunds: Airline tickets issued by Regina Tours are highly restrictive and in most instances cannot be reissued, revaluated or exchanged. If a change is possible, a \$75 per person administrative fee, plus any applicable airline change fees, will be assessed once air tickets have been issued. Airline penalties vary depending on carrier.

Airline Seat Assignments and Special Services: There is no advance seat selection. Early check-in is necessary to secure seats with travel companions. Seating is solely under control of the airlines. Some airfares used may be eligible for frequent flyer mileage.

Baggage: The company is not responsible for any additional charges collected by the carriers at the airport for luggage fees. We recommend that you take along one suitcase per person with a maximum weight of 50lbs., plus one carry on with maximum dimensions of 9"X14"X22". Airlines also have their own baggage restrictions; please check with the air carrier prior to your departure. All baggage is the passenger's responsibility throughout the tour. Regina Tours is not responsible for loss, theft or damage to your baggage. If a bag is lost or damaged In-flight, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly.

Airline Clause: The airlines concerned will not be held responsible for any act, omission, or event during the time passengers are not aboard their aircraft. The passenger tickets in use by the airline, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between airline and the purchaser of these tickets and/or passenger. These tours may be sold in connection with the services of any ATC or IATA Airline.

Rooms: Prices shown in the brochure are per person, based on two persons sharing a hotel room or cabin. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement shown per tour. In some cases, when requested, we may be able to find an appropriate roommate for passengers who have booked as a single person. If a roommate is not available, you must pay the single room supplement. While single rooms provide privacy they are often smaller than twin bedrooms. Triple rooms are available in many hotels for family or friends traveling together. There are no discounts for triple rooms.

Medical Conditions While we endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers, we cannot guarantee special facilities or assistance for disabled passengers and it is your responsibility to arrange for such assistance as required. Land Only Bookings & Tour Deviations: All Regina Tours packages include airfare from the city designated. Land only bookings will be invoiced based on adjusted price. Arrival and departure transfers are not provided for land only bookings. Any deviations from the tour, requested by the client, will be assessed a charge of \$100.00 per person, plus any additional costs the change may incur.

If you cancel your tour after you have received your documents and airline tickets, you must return them to Regina Tours before we can process your refund.
