DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day 1 – Nov 5th USA/ISRAEL

Depart from Little Rock Airport on a super jet to Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv. Dinner and breakfast will be served aboard.

Day 2 – Nov 6th TEL AVIV/TIBERIAS

Upon arrival in Tel Aviv, we will be greeted by our Tour Escort, board our deluxe motor coach and transfer to our hotel in Tiberias on the Sea of Galilee. Already we can feel the heart of this land enchanting us, as we visit the sites of the Bible and share the experience of walking in the footsteps of Jesus. Dinner and overnight. (D)

Day 3 – Nov 7th HAIFA/NAZARETH/CANA/TIBERIAS

Drive along the Mediterranean coast to Caesarea where Peter baptized Cornelius (Acts 10:24). Visit the Roman theater, the aqueduct, and Herodian Port. Continue on to Haifa. See the magnificent panoramic view from the top of the mountain at Mukraka, the location of Elijah's altar located at Stella Maris, a Carmelite Monastery. Here Elijah confronted the priests of Baal (1 Kings 18). Continue to the Sea of Galilee via the Valley of Armageddon. Continue up the mountains to Nazareth, boyhood town of Jesus. Visit the Church of Annunciation (Luke 2:46) built over Mary's childhood home where Mass will be celebrated. Here the Angel Gabriel appeared to Mary, announcing she would bear the Son of God, (Luke 1:30-34) and Mary said Yes to God. We make a stop at Church of St. Joseph built over his workshop and was home to the Holy Family. Visit the Church of Mary's Well where Mary drew water every day. Then on to Cana, site of Jesus' first miracle (John 2:1). Here couples can renew their marriage vows. Drive back to Tiberias on the Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight. (B,D)



Day 4 – Nov 8th CAPERNAUM/TABGA/CAESAREA PHILIP/MAGDALA/TIBERIAS

Take a boat ride from Tiberias across the Sea of Galilee to the village of Capernaum. Visit the ruins of St. Peter's House where Jesus stayed while He was preaching in the local synagogue. Visit the second-century synagogue and proceed to Tabgha. Here we will visit the Church of St. Peter's Primacy (John 21:15) where Jesus appeared to the disciples after his resurrection. Next we visit the Church of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes (Mark 6:44). Proceed to the

Mt. of Beatitudes, overlooking the Sea of Galilee, where Jesus gave the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5:1). Mass will be celebrated. Then travel to Caesarea Phillip where St. Peter proclaimed Jesus as the Messiah (Matthew 16:13). Jesus replied that Peter was the rock on which the church would be built. As we drive back to our hotel, we pass Magdala, home of Mary Magdalene and make a stop at this new uncovered pilgrim site. There will be time to walk around the uncovered buildings and trace the steps of Jesus and His Disciples as they spent time preaching, healing and relaxing with friends. Dinner and overnight. (B,D)

Day 5 – Nov 9th BAPTISMAL SITE/MT. TABOR JERUSALEM

This morning we leave the Sea of Galilee for Yardenit, baptismal site on the Jordan River. Here we will renew our Baptismal Covenant. Proceeding on to Mt. Tabor, site of the Transfiguration (Matthew 17:2), we will ascend the mountain to the Church of the Transfiguration where Mass will be celebrated. We will have time to reflect on Jesus's Humanity and Divinity. Continue to the old Roman city of Beit Shean to visit the impressive ruins. Drive along the Gilboa mountain range to Prophet Gideon's Spring and onto the Tel of Jezreel, the location of Queen Jezebel's summer palace where we hear about the site's intimate connection with Old Testament events. From here we venture south towards the holy city of Jerusalem. Dinner & overnight in Jerusalem. (B,D)



Day 6 – Nov 10th OLD CITY/BETHLEHEM/JERUSALEM

Visit the Model of Ancient Jerusalem to see how it was in the Lord's day, then on to the Old City. We will enter through St. Stephen's Gate to St. Ann's Church, birthplace of our Blessed Lady. See the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the lame man (John 5:2). We will continue onto the Via Dolorosa 'The Way of the Cross' (Luke 23:1). We will process carrying a wooden cross (starting at Pilate's Judgment Hall and stopping to pray at each station) all the way 'to Calvary and the Tomb' at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. We will celebrate Mass. We will stand at the Western Wall, ascend Temple Mount to the Dome of the Rock and the Al Aksa Mosque, winding our way through the ancient cobblestone alleyways amidst the colorful bazaars. In the afternoon, drive to nearby Bethlehem of Judea (The House of Bread), birthplace of Jesus (Matthew 2:1). Visit the Church of the Nativity, on the site of the Manger where Joseph came with Mary and where the Wisemen came to worship the King of Kings. We will see the Milk Grotto and the Cave of St. Jerome, where the 3rd century saint translated the

Latin Vulgate. Celebrate Mass. Afterwards we will stand on Shepherds Field, where the Angel proclaimed the Good News 'Jesus Is Born' (Luke 2:8). As we depart we will visit the Tomb of the Matriarch Rachel — mother of Joseph of the Old Testament. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (B,D)



QUMRAN CAVES
Leave Jerusalem via Bethany to visit Lazarus Tomb (John 11:43) where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead. We will celebrate Mass. Continue to the Dead Sea (deepest point on earth), to visit the Qumran Caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found and on to Masada. Ascend to the top for a magnificent view of the desert. We will have time for a "swim" in the Dead Sea, visit Ein Gedi, and return to Jerusalem via the Judean Wilderness. Dinner and overnight. (B,D)

Day 8 - Nov 12th **JERUSALEM**
A full day of leisure to pursue personal interests or shop. (B,D)

Day 9 - Nov 13th **JERUSALEM/EIN KAREM**
Drive to the Mt. of Olives for an outstanding view of the City and surrounding area. After visiting the place of the Ascension and the Church of Pater Noster (Acts 1:9) where Jesus taught the disciples the Lord's Prayer, we will walk down the hill to Dominus Flevit where Jesus wept over Jerusalem (Luke 19:41). Proceed to the Garden of Gethsemane (Mark 14:32), where Jesus brought His disciples to pray the night before He was crucified. The garden still contains the trees dating back to Jesus's time. Next is the Church of All Nations built over the "Rock of Agony" where Jesus prayed alone the night of His arrest. Mass can be celebrated here. See the Kidron Valley, Tomb of Absalom, Zachariah and James as we continue on to Mt. Zion, to the Church of the Dormition, where tradition tells us Mary the Mother of Jesus "fell asleep". Next visit the Room of the Last Supper (Luke 22:

7) where Jesus and His disciples celebrated the Last Supper (Matt 26 7-30) and the King David's Tomb. Proceed to the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, (The Cock Crows) (Mark 14:30) where Peter denied Jesus three times. Continue to the Church of the Visitation, the original site of the Magnificat (Luke 1:41), then to Ein Karem, birthplace of St. John the Baptist. Our final stop will be at Emmaus where Jesus appeared to his followers following his Resurrection (Luke 24:30-31). Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight (B,D)

Day 10 - Nov. 14th **TEL AVIV/USA**
After an early breakfast we transfer to the airport for our flight home taking with us spirit filled memories and blessings as we arrive home the same day. (B).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Tour prices: All prices in this brochure are based on airfares, land rates and exchange rates in effect at the time of printing and on group rates of 22 passengers or more. Tours may depart with less than the required number of passengers, at the discretion of Group IST, LLC (doing business and referred to therein as "Regina Tours"), but an additional charge may apply. Passengers will be advised about such surcharges 60 days before departure. All prices are subject to change without notice prior to departure due to major currency fluctuations, changes in fuel prices and/or unforeseen economic circumstances.

Reservations, Deposits and Final Payments: Please complete the Participant Agreement, with full names as they appear on passports, and mail it to us with the required per person deposit plus applicable (optional) insurance. Receipt of your deposit shall act as your agreement to these terms and conditions. Balance is due 60 days before departure date. If final payment is received less than 60 days, a late fee will be assessed in the amount of \$50.00. If final payment is made by credit card (American Express, Visa, MasterCard), Regina Tours requires a completed credit card authorization form. All payments made by check should be made payable to Regina Tours.

Late Reservations If a booking is made within 60 days of departure, full payment plus applicable taxes and optional insurance is due at the time of booking. There will be a \$50.00 late processing fee applicable plus cost of any express or overnight mail services. No personal checks will be accepted with reservations received 30 days or less before departure date. Money order, bank check, certified check or credit cards (American Express, Visa, and MasterCard) will be accepted.

Travel Documents: A valid passport (valid for six months after the return date of the trip) is required to travel. Visa is required for US passport holders traveling to some destinations; please contact our office for details. All non-US citizens must contact the appropriate consular office for entry visa requirements pertaining to their trip. In addition non US citizens are responsible for complying with requirements for re-entry into the USA. Regina Tours assumes no responsibility for procurement of passport or visas. Obtaining and carrying these documents is the sole responsibility of passengers. Regina Tours will not be responsible for any delays, damages and/or losses, including missed portions of your trip due to improper travel documentation

Final Documents and Tickets All documents and tickets are only issued upon receipt of final payment and are sent within 3 weeks of departure. Documents and tickets are not guaranteed if final payment and booking form are not received on time.

Air from Home City: All brochure departures are based on a New York area airport. Regina Tours can help arrange air transportation from your home city airport. Regina Tours is not responsible for any penalties incurred on domestic tickets not purchased from us, in case of changes in the schedule of the tour. If you are making your own domestic airline tickets, please make sure that your domestic flight time arrives at least 4 hours prior to your international departure time.

Air Changes, Cancellations & Refunds: Airline tickets issued by Regina Tours are highly restrictive and in most instances cannot be reissued, revaluated or exchanged. If a change is possible, a \$75 per person administrative fee, plus any applicable airline change fees, will be assessed once air tickets have been issued. Airline penalties vary depending on carrier.
