YOUR DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

June 27 Little Rock Today we meet at the airport for our flights to Rome. Meals and entertainment served on board.

June 28 Rome/Assisi Upon arrival in Fiumicino airport our escort will meet us and guide us to the bus as we drive north through the Umbria region and end up in Assisi, home of the beloved St. Francis. Upon arrival we visit St Mary of the Angels Basilica with the Chapel of the Portiuncola, Rose Bush, and the Cave where he retired for prayer. Overnight in Assisi.

June 29 Assisi Breakfast and start our walking guided tour of Assisi. Visit S. Francis Basilica with the tomb of the Saint and the beautiful Giotto painting. Visit the Basilica of Saint Claire and continue to the Hermitage. The sanctuary of Saint Francis, or the Franciscan Hermitage, in Monteluco at an altitude of 800 meters not far from the ancient sacred wood and some natural caves that were already inhabited by hermits in the early Christian era. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Assisi.

June 30 Assisi/Rome Breakfast in hotel and check out. Say goodbye to Assisi and journey to Rome the “Eternal City”. and start your city tour with the Basilica of Saint John Lateran, the Cathedral of Rome, then across the square to see the Holy Steps believed to be the stairs climbed by Jesus when he was condemned to death: Church of the Holy Cross of Jerusalem which contains several holy relics from the Passion of Christ: next is the Church of San Clemente dedicated to Pope St. Clement the First where we will admire the spectacular mosaics and frescoes. Free time for lunch. Visit to St Paul Outside the Walls built over the saints tomb and then to the Catacombs where early Christians were laid to rest.

July 1 Rome Breakfast in the hotel. Early morning Mass at Saint Peter’s Basilica, we start our bus tour to Gesu Church, the Mother church of the Society of Jesus (Jesuits), where St. Ignatius of Loyola is buried. Continue to Pantheon which was originally a temple to the ancient Roman Gods, Largo Argentina site of Pompey’s Theater dating back to 55BC and the site where Julius Caesar was killed. Last stop is a tour to Church of Santa Maria Sopra Minerva.

July 2 Rome Breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to Vatican to attend the Papal audience. Free time for lunch. In the afternoon your visit to the Vatican, and its glorious art treasures, will be a highlight of your stay in Rome. View the vast collection of art and antiquities in the Vatican-Museums. Your guide will lead you to the Sistine Chapel through a portion of these treasures such as the Candelabra Gallery where you can admire the Greek - Roman art, the Tapestries with the most extraordinary Flemish works and the Map Gallery with exceptional geographical details*. Visit the Sistine Chapel, where Michelangelo’s ceiling fresco depicting the history of the creation and the Last Judgement overlooks Italian art masterpieces. Visit St. Peter’s Basilica, surrounding the world’s largest church. While Bernini designed most of works found in the church, Michelangelo’s Pietà is also housed here; St. Peter’s Square. Overnight in Rome.

July 3 Rome Breakfast and transfer to visit the Church of Santa Praseseda built over the tombs of two sisters, two early saints converted by St. Peter. Our next stop is a visit to the Basilica of Mary Major, principle Church on earth dedicated to the Blessed Mother. Balance of the day at leisure. Overnight in Rome.

July 4 Rome-Lanciano-Rome Breakfast. Early morning depart for a full day trip to Lanciano to see the 8th century Eucharistic Miracle. Upon arrival we stop at the Church of St. Legontian. We will celebrate Mass, tour the church, have some free time before we return to Rome in the evening. Overnight in Rome.

July 5 Rome Breakfast and transfer to the city center with a stroll among the Piazzas: Spanish Steps, Piazza Navona, Trevi Fountain. We will visit the Church of Santa Maria Ara Coeli to see the relics of St. Helena A visit to the Mamertine Prison, Church of Saint Peter in Chains is next where we will celebrate Mass and see the chains that bound St. Peter Next stop is a visit to the Basilica of Mary Major, principle Church on earth dedicated to the Blessed Mother. Farewell dinner with Operamusic and overnight in Rome.

July 6 Rome/Little Rock After breakfast, transfer to the airport for our flight home, arriving the same day, taking with us memories and blessings to last a life time.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Tour prices: All prices in this brochure are based on land rates and exchange rates in effect at the time of printing and on group rates of 30 passengers or more. Tours may depart with less than the required number of passengers, at the discretion of Group IST, LLC (doing business and referred to therein as “Regina Tours”), but an additional charge may apply. Passengers will be advised about such surcharges 60 days before departure. All prices are subject to change without notice prior to departure due to major currency fluctuations, changes in fuel prices and/or unforeseen economic circumstances.

Reservations, Deposits and Final Payments: Please complete the Participant Agreement, with full names as they appear on passports, and mail it to us with the required per person deposit plus applicable (optional) insurance. Receipt of your deposit shall act as your agreement to these terms and conditions. Balance is due 60 days before departure date. If final payment is received less than 60 days, a late fee will be accessed in the amount of \$50.00. If final payment is made by credit card (American Express, Visa, MasterCard), Regina Tours requires a completed credit card authorization form. All payments made by check should be made payable to Sue Smith Vacations, Attention Kathy Primm.

Late Reservations: If a booking is made within 60 days of departure, full payment plus applicable taxes and optional insurance is due at the time of booking. There will be a \$50.00 late processing fee applicable plus cost of any express or overnight mail services. No personal checks will be accepted with reservations received 30 days or less before departure date. Money order, bank check, certified check or credit cards (American Express, Visa, and MasterCard) will be accepted.

Travel Documents: A valid passport (valid for six months after the return date of the trip) is required to travel. Visa is required for US passport holders traveling to some destinations; please contact our office for details. All non-US citizens must contact the appropriate consular office for entry visa requirements pertaining to their trip. In addition non US citizens are responsible for complying with requirements for re-entry into the USA. Regina Tours assumes no responsibility for procurement of passport or visas. Obtaining and carrying these documents is the sole responsibility of passengers. Regina Tours will not be responsible for any delays, damages and/or losses, including missed portions of your trip due to improper travel documentation.

Final Documents and Tickets: All documents and tickets are only issued upon receipt of final payment and are sent within 3 weeks of departure. Documents and tickets are not guaranteed if final payment and booking form are not received on time.

Air from Home City: Flights will be available 325 days before travel. Sue Smith Vacations can help arrange air transportation from your home city airport. Sue Smith Vacations is not responsible for any penalties incurred on domestic tickets not purchased from us, in case of changes in the schedule of the tour. If you are making your own domestic airline tickets, please make sure that your domestic flight time arrives at least 4 hours prior to your international departure time.

Air Changes, Cancellations & Refunds: Airline tickets issued by Regina Tours are highly restrictive and in most instances cannot be reissued, revalidated or exchanged. If a change is possible, a \$75 per person administrative fee, plus any applicable airline change fees, will be assessed once air tickets have been issued. Airline penalties vary depending on carrier.

Airline Seat Assignments and Special Services: There is no advance seat selection. Early check-in is necessary to secure seats with travel companions. Seating is solely under control of the airlines. Some airfares used may be eligible for frequent flyer mileage.

Baggage: The company is not responsible for any additional charges collected by the carriers at the airport for luggage fees. We recommend that you take along one suitcase per person with a maximum weight of 50lbs., plus one carry on with maximum dimensions of 9”X14”X22”. Airlines also have their own baggage restrictions; please check with the air carrier prior to your departure. All baggage is the passenger’s responsibility throughout the tour. Regina Tours is not responsible for loss, theft or damage to your baggage. If a bag is lost or damaged In-flight, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly.

Airline Clause: The airlines concerned will not be held responsible for any act, omission, or event during the time passengers are not aboard their aircraft. These tours may be sold in connection with the services of any ATC or IATA Airline.

Rooms: Prices shown in the brochure are per person, based on two persons sharing a hotel room or cabin. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement shown per tour. In some cases, when requested, we may be able to find an appropriate roommate for passengers who have booked as a single person. If a roommate is not available, you must pay the single room supplement. While single rooms provide privacy they are often smaller than twin bedrooms. Triple rooms are available in many hotels for family or friends traveling together. There are no discounts for triple rooms.

Land Only Bookings & Tour Deviations: All Tours packages include airfare from the city designated. Land only bookings will be invoiced based on adjusted price. Arrival and departure transfers are not provided for land only bookings. Any deviations from the tour, requested by the client, will be assessed a charge of \$100.00 per person, plus any additional costs the change may incur.
